## InOutBoard Web Site

A new filter choice on the status board allows users to filter by name. This is helpful when the status board has a large number of employees. If you type "MI" in the name filter, only employees with a first OR last name starting with MI will be shown.

The Time History Report now provides report totals for In, Out, and PTO.

When a user selects "Tomorrow" for the quick set return time when changing status, the program defaults the return time to the users beginning of shift time tomorrow based on their user profile.

Password controls have been strengthened and secured, especially when changing passwords.

We are introducing regional settings in the company profile to better deal with date and time presentation issues around the world. The company "Locale" setting is consistent with Microsoft standards. Selecting a particular setting will change the date and time presentation on a future release, but the current release simply records the company preference.

Several behind-the-scenes security issues have been addressed to detect and prevent unauthorized access or hacking.

## InOutBoard Agent

Users with level 4 security - employees with limited access, are not allowed to use the agent now.

Chat services have been improved so access is faster and so temporary loss of connectivity does not create error conditions. All known chat service issues have been addressed with this release.

An issue with the Agent not working properly with Citrix or Terminal Services has been addressed.

Employees now have the option to save chat sessions to a file. This is helpful for audit purposes or if important information is being shared that needs to be saved for later use.

Users now have a new setup option to have the agent automatically ask for a status change whenever the agent is started or the user logs in.

A review of agent time zone features has been completed and all time zone issues with the agent have been corrected.

The automated or "silent" update for new agent releases has been improved so that the user is given an alert that an update is occurring but otherwise is not required to do anything or answer any questions. Users may still experience some popup windows with this release but not with future ones.
